Finance (Chair: Roger Allison)

- OT100MTB Report
 - 2016 race will be the weekend of "National Public Lands Day" Sep 24 25, 2016
 - Kick Off planning meeting will be held soon
- DNR Proposal
 - Discussion about DNR contracting with the OTA to build the trail at CRSP has taken place twice now. Still waiting on word back, but hopefully something will be decided this week.
- Lattner Grant
 - Grant proposal has been submitted and we should hear back on it in December. Items in the grant included operations support and people tracking database.
- RTP 2014 reimbursement
 - Abi is doing a follow up on status of check
- RTP 2015 and rollover of RTP 2011
 - 2015 RTP for Berryman work and mowing has been awarded
 - Still awaiting word on 2011 status
- 2016 Trivia Night
 - o Tentative date is February 20th
 - Don Schulte is working his list of things that need to be done
- Membership Drive
 - Discussion was held on different ways to do a fall membership drive
