### **Office Related**

- Granger-Thye Agreement with the USFS for the OTA Office Building
  - We need to complete the 9 tasks that were identified in 2015 under this agreement, the roof replacement is the major item. Targeting May 7<sup>th</sup> for the primary date on the roof with a May 14<sup>th</sup> backup date.
  - We need to develop a list of 2016 tasks

## **Construction and Maintenance of New and Existing Trails**

- Initial contact with members of the C&M committee. No formal meetings have been held. A conference call format is being developed for members to begin in May Action Items Discussed
- A meeting was held on Feb. 22 with Jonathan Brooks(USFS) at the OTA house. Discussions concerning the
  role of the OTA with the USFS and the role each of the entities would have with the OT. Cost share
  summer mowing program will be with USFS with AmeriCorp. Discussion still needs to happen on
  supervision of program.
- Jensen Point work was completed by OTA volunteers as to fulfill the obligation of the OTA. Re-dedication will be Monday, May 30th.
- MDC Peck Ranch A 7 m road -"bushwhacking" trail was completed to allow hikers to be able to do a
  through hike of the Current River section of the OT. Thanks for Todd Horn and Matt Atnip for pursuing
  the vision and technical aspect of it. New maps are posted on the OTA web site.
- Work was completed on the garage and basement to ensure that equipment is properly stored and
  available for volunteers to check out for events and work within the OT system and the AAT Program. A
  white board has been hung in the basement with information concerning current, future and ongoing
  projects and concerns
- Mega Event
  - 215 plus 30 kids discussing if there is a need to close the registration
  - o All tasks are pretty much on track
  - As of this date the trail has not been dozed yet
- Summer Mowing
  - Cost Share is in place, \$12K for labor, \$3K for supplies, etc.
  - Roger has been talking to Bruce Baily, AmeriCorps about a 4-person crew, issue may be if we can afford a manager to oversee the crew
  - The mowing binder needs to be reviewed
