  - The poster size map is nearing completion
    - Mark Goforth showed 2 samples of the large maps funded by LAD
      - 1<sup>st</sup> one is standard poster size and is a modification of the one that was developed for the 2015 Trails Symposium
      - 2<sup>nd</sup> one is also standard poster size and it a topo variety with not as much text on it and it shows more of the SE side of the state
      - Discussion was held on style to use, cost, and how many
      - Decision was made for 2500 of 2-side maps (both demos) and sell @ \$15 plus shipping
